About the Company's Policy Regarding Personal Information

This Notice about **SWI Inc.** (hereinafter referred to as the Company), regarding personal information describes the conditions under which we (hereinafter "we" means the Company) collect, store, use and protect your (hereinafter "you", "of you", "your" means the User) personal information (hereinafter the totality of the above processes means "Policy"). You are covered by the Policy from the moment you conclude the Agreement.

In this Policy, we use the term "Personal Information" to describe information that can be associated with a particular natural person and can be used to identify that person. We do not consider anonymous information as personal one, since it cannot identify a specific User.

In this Policy, we use the term "Site" when referring to the Company's website:

1. Collection of Personal Information

1.1. When you visit the Site, we enter the information about your IP address and standard web-log information, such as your browser type and the pages you accessed on our Site.

1.2. If you intend to use the personal account of the Site, we need the information about you in the amount provided by the relevant columns to be filled out in your personal account of the Site. In order to simplify communication with us, we suggest filling out the relevant section of the personal account with up-to-date personal data.

1.3. Before we allow you to use our services, we may need additional information that will allow us to verify the basic information about your identity, or address, or the degree of risk. We can also get information about you from third parties or use personal identification services.

1.4. When you use the personal website account provided to you, we collect the information about transactions on your accounts. We can also collect the information about your computer or other means of access in order to prevent fraud.

1.5. We can collect some additional information about you in other ways not described in this Notification. For example, we can collect the information related to your contacts with our customer support service or store the results of your answers to questions.

2. Cookies

2.1. When you visit our Site, we, or the companies that we hire to monitor how much our site is used, can host small data files on your computer, called "cookies" (cookies).

2.2. We send a "session cookie" (session cookie) to your computer when you log in to your account. This type of cookie helps us to recognize you if you visit several pages on our Site during the same session, so that we do not have to request your password on each page. When you log out or close the browser, this cookie expires and is no longer valid.

2.3. We also use longer "cookies" for other purposes, for example, to display your e-mail address in our authorization form, so that you do not need to re-enter your e-mail address every time you enter your Office.

2.4. We code our "cookies", so that only we can understand the information stored in them. You can opt out of our "cookies" if your browser allows doing that, but this may prevent you from using our Site. In addition, we can collect information about your computer or other means of access to reduce risk and to prevent fraud.

3. Protection of Personal Information

3.1. We store and process your personal information on dedicated servers with a high

degree of protection, and we protect it by supporting physical, electronic and protocol guarantees in accordance with the applicable law of the relevant jurisdiction. We use computer security methods, such as firewalls and data encryption. We apply physical access control to our buildings and files and allow access to personal information only to those employees who need it to perform their job duties.

4. Use of Personal Information

4.1. Our main goal in collecting personal information is to provide you with a safe, comfortable, efficient and personalized service. We may use your personal information for:

- Provision of services and support to users at their request;
- making transactions in the personal account and sending notifications of these transactions;
- documents processing;
- resolution of disputes, collection of payment and elimination of problems;
- prevention of potentially prohibited or illegal activities and enforcement of contracts;
- customization, evaluation and improvement of our services, content and structure of the Site;
- sending you targeted marketing, notifications of updates and promotional offers based on your preferences;
- Verifying information for accuracy and reconciling it with third parties.

5. Provision of Personal Information to other users and companies-operators.

5.1. If you make a transaction through the Site and pay for it from the current personal account in your personal office, we can also provide the operator of the payment system or special

5.2. payment service that transfers funds to the Company, your personal data to help complete your settlement with the Company.

5.3. We work with various payment systems and services to be able to accept payments from users. At the same time, when you make a payment, the operator can share with you such information about you as your e-mail address or wallet number (of your personal account), etc. We use this information to confirm that you are a user and that your counterparty has the right to take cash from you. Also, at your request, we can confirm your status of the user of the Site to a third party. Please note that the operator companies through which you transfer funds to the Company and with whom you contract are subject to their own confidentiality agreement and the Seller is not responsible for their activities, including but not limited to their practice of Work with information.

5.4. If you make a transaction through the Site, your Personal information will be used to process the necessary documents and send it to the counterparty.

6. Exchange of personal information with third parties.

6.1. We may transfer your Personal Information to:

- The Company's partners to provide joint services and provide content (for example, registration, transactions and customer support); to help detect and prevent potentially illegal actions and violations of our rules; and to make decisions about products, services and communications. Our partners will use this information to send you marketing communications only if you requested their services.
- Contract service providers, which partially assist in our business operations:

fraud prevention, account collection, marketing, technology, services. Our contracts require these service providers to use information only in connection with the services they provide to us, and not for their own benefit.

- Companies with which we plan to unite with or the ones which we will be acquired by. (If such an association occurs, we will require that the new joint company follows this Policy. If your Personal Information can be used in a different way, you will be notified in advance.)
- Law enforcement authorities, government officials or other third parties, when:
 - we are forced to do so in accordance with the agenda, court order or similar legal procedure;
 - we must do so in accordance with the law;
 - we do it of our own free will, believing that the disclosure of Personal Information is necessary to prevent physical harm or financial loss; to report suspected illegal actions or to investigate violations of our Policy. Other third parties, with your consent or at your direction.

6.2. The Seller will not sell or transfer to use any of your Personal Information to third parties for marketing purposes and will share your Personal Information with third parties only as described in this Policy.

7. Access and Change of your Personal Information.

7.1. You can revise and edit your Personal Information at any time, in your personal office of the site.
